

## LEOPARDO FILMES

Created in 2007, LEOPARDO FILMES continues the work of more than 30 years of producer PAULO BRANCO.

It is the producer of the **Lisbon & Sintra Film Festival**, a festival that addresses the interconnection between different cultural proposals: from film to literature, through to music and the visual arts, and emerges as a place that supports reflection and debate of current topics, gathering together film-makers, thinkers, artists and audiences.

During its eleven editions (2007/2017) it has been attended by a large number of personalities from the national and international arts and film scene, such as David Lynch, Wim Wenders, Pedro Almodóvar, Bernardo Bertolucci, Francis Ford Coppola, David Cronenberg; Emir Kusturica, Jim Jarmusch, Nanni Moretti, Julian Schnabel, Juliette Binoche, Louis Garrel, Valeria Bruni-Tedeschi, Catherine Deneuve, Isabelle Huppert, Julião Sarmento, Paul Auster, Don DeLillo, J.M. Coetzee, Rui Horta, David Byrne, Cindy Sherman, Lou Reed, Laurie Anderson, Stephen Frears, John Malkovich, Matthew Barney, Paul Giamatti, Yasmina Reza, Luc Dardenne, James Gray, Arnaud Desplechin, Aleksandr Sokurov, Abdellatif Kechiche, Fanny Ardant, Wes Anderson, Abel Ferrara, Willem Dafoe, Laura Poitras, Nan Goldin, Peter Handke, Philippe Garrel, Emanuel Ungaro, Andrzej Zulawski, amongst others.

It quickly made a name for itself as a film producer, and its portfolio includes films by long-established talented and original directors and also by young newcomers, since Paulo Branco's philosophy has always been one of investing in new directors.

The aim is to open up a new range of possibilities that leverage an increasing interconnection between film producers (international co-productions) and, consequently, the sharing of different film cultures, acting as a hub for the promotion/internationalisation of Portuguese films around the world.

Therefore, it already plays a significant role in world cinema, not only because of the undeniable artistic and cultural quality of its projects, already premiered or under development (Hugo Vieira da Silva, Carlos Saboga, João Nuno Pinto, etc.), but foremost for its unique results in terms of the national and international acceptance of the works produced, of which "Cosmopolis", "Mistérios de Lisboa", "Linhas de Wellington", "Cosmos" and "À Jamais" stand out.

Leopardo Filmes is also the main independent film distributor, acting in the commercial theatre house circuit, film societies and the production of DVDs for the Portuguese market, with two current major successes: the premiere of some of the best films of the year, such as "Paterson", by Jim Jarmusch, "Barbara", by Mathieu Amalric, "Ma Loute", by Bruno Dumont, "The Day After", by Hong Sangsoo, and the re-exhibition of films in newly restored digital versions, including Wim Wenders's and a gigantic retrospective series of a century of Russian cinema, with the screening of several films never before seen in Portugal.

The track record of Leopardo Filmes, the experience gained throughout these seven years and the more than 30 years of contacts of its Director and Festival Programmer, the producer and distributor Paulo Branco, are the guarantee that, year after year, we will continue to grow, innovate and surpass ourselves.
